## REOPENING PROCEDURES

Now that we have navigated through the first few weeks of the Green Phase, we are ready to move forward with additional re-opening opportunities. One such opportunity will be the return of the Saturday evening mass. Our first 4:00 P.M. mass will be celebrated on Saturday, June 27. Doors will open at 3:30 P.M. You will be required to follow the directives for attending mass as stated in my last letter. Additionally, those wishing to attend must call the rectory at 570-696-3737 on Thursday, June 25, between 10 A.M. and Noon ONLY to make a reservation.

We will ask your name, phone number, and the number of people in your household attending the mass. We are able to accept 40 reservations only. Once we have reached our limit, the reservations will be closed for the 4 PM mass that weekend. This procedure will continue each week into the foreseeable future. We hope to restart our Sunday morning mass soon.

We also plan to offer Holy Communion at St. Therese's in Shavertown on Sunday, June 28, following the 10:00 A.M. Live-Stream Mass.

*This will be done on a trial-basis only.*

Interested parties are welcome to park in either of the Church's lower parking lots, beginning at 11:15 A.M. and ending at Noon, and await direction from the attendants to proceed in the car to the upper parking lot (adjacent to the rectory). Once there, participants will be expected to exit their car wearing a mask, approach the communion station while observing social distancing, receive communion, return to their car, and exit the upper lot by turning left onto Davis Street and proceeding to Stafford Street.

Although there is no limit to the number of participants, we would ask that you consider carpooling in order to assist us with crowd control. Ever grateful for your kind cooperation and patience,
