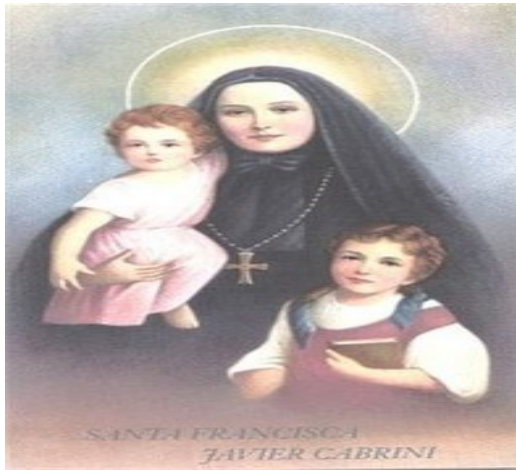

TOP 10 ANSWERS TO YOUR QUESTIONS

1. Q: Why can we only seat 40 people in the Church if 25% of our capacity is 60+?

A: Because we have to observe social distancing which means our guests must be seated 6 feet apart from one another.

2. Q: Why is Holy Communion distributed at the end of Mass?

A: To prevent the faithful from returning to their seats and possibly contaminating others on the way.

3. Q: When will our liturgical ministers be allowed to read, serve, usher and sing again?

A: When more restrictions are lifted. Meanwhile, we are limiting ministries to contain the spread of the virus.

4. Q: Why are some of the Church doors locked during Mass?

A: To prevent the spread of germs and reduce the amount of sanitizing that must be done at the end of every mass.

5. Q: Why doesn't Father have to wear a mask during Mass?

A: Because he is more than 6 feet away from those in the pews and because he needs to be heard by those attending mass.

6. Q: Is there an obligation to attend Sunday Mass?

A: No. The obligation has been suspended until further notice.

7. Q: Can a Funeral or Memorial Mass be celebrated in the Church?

A: Yes. But certain restrictions and guidelines must be followed for the safety and well-being of those in attendance.

8. Q: Do children have to wear masks to Church?

A: Yes, according to State regulations, children over the age of two must wear masks when out in public.

9. Q: Will the faithful be allowed to receive the Precious Blood of Christ from the cup anytime soon?

A: It is unlikely that the distribution of the Precious Blood will return to the Mass in the near future. Meanwhile, know that Jesus is present, body-soul and divinity, in the Eucharistic Bread.

10. Q: When will all of this end?

A: Only God knows...and that's the truth!!!
