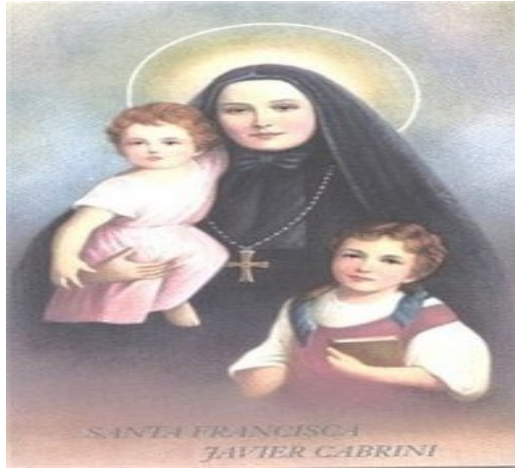

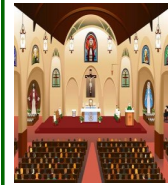
AN ACT OF
