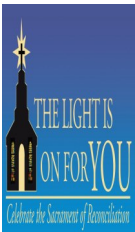


STAY AWAKE SPIRITUALLY

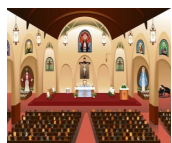
