We have so much to be grateful for.

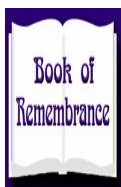
IN THANKSGIVING FOR YOUR KINDNESS

BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF SCRANTON
In light of the rising COVID infection rates due to the delta variant, Bishop Bambara reminds us of the importance of continued vigilance in all activities and offers the following:

1. MASKS: WHILE MASKS ARE NOT CURRENTLY MANDATED, IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT ALL PARISHIONERS WEAR MASKS WHILE ATTENDING MASS, REGARDLESS OF THEIR VACCINATION STATUS.
2. All Priests, Deacons, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion should sanitize their hands in preparation of and wear a mask during the distribution of Holy Communion. Altar servers should also wear a mask while performing their duties.

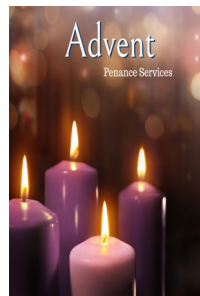
