*As Jesus fasted 40 days in the desert, the Church traditionally fasts during Lent. A form of bodily prayer, fasting and abstinence in union with other Christians reminds us of our utter dependence on and love for God. A gesture of repentance, fasting is symbolic of a change of heart as we turn away from sin to live in fidelity to the Gospel. **FASTING:** Ages 18-59 fast on Good Friday, limiting ourselves to one full meal and two small meals each day, with no snacking between meals. **ABSTINENCE:** Catholics age 14 and older abstain from meat on Good Friday.*
