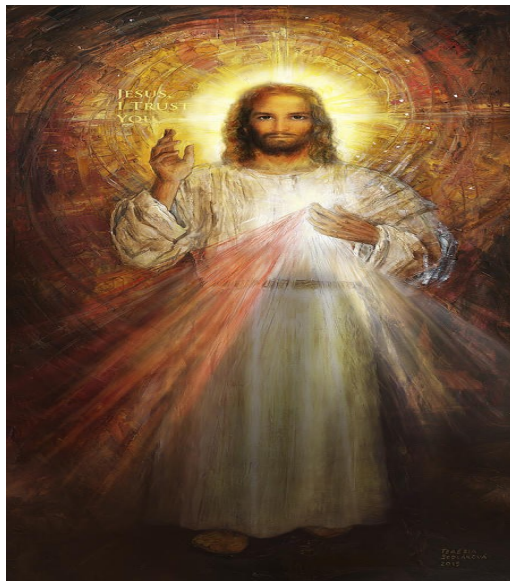

and receive new life*

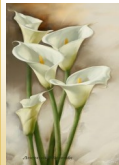

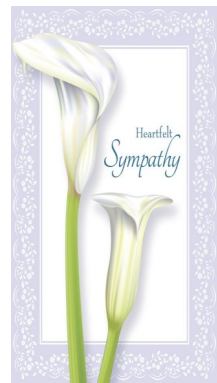
