*The True Nature of Peace*

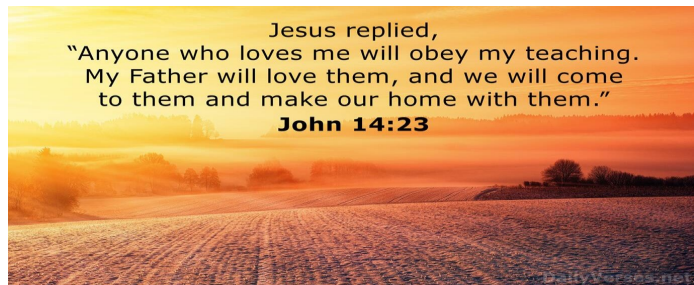
