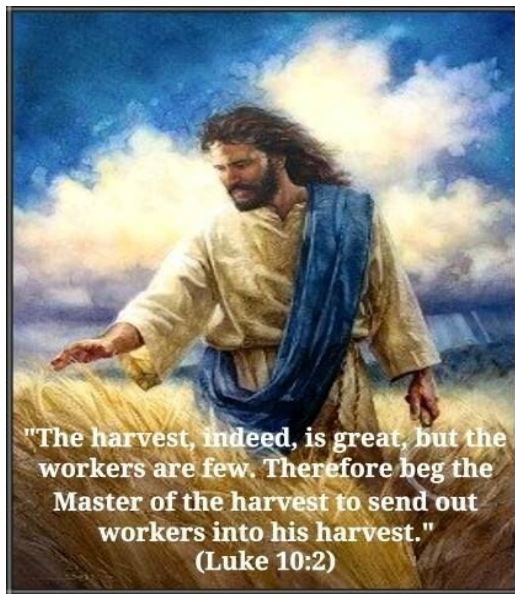

What is the significance of Jesus appointing seventy disciples to the ministry of the word? Seventy was a significant number in biblical times. Moses chose seventy elders to in the task of leading the people through the wilderness. The Jewish Sanhedrin, the governing council of Israel, was composed of seventy members. In Jesus' times seventy was held to be the number of nations throughout the world.

Jesus commissioned the seventy to speak in his name and to act with his power. The word of God is sown in the hearts of receptive men and women who hear his word, accept it with trust, and then share the abundant fruit of God's word in their life with others. 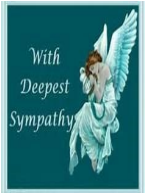
