**THE HUMBLE RECOGNIZE
THEIR NEED FOR GOD'S
MERCY AND HELP**

This parable presents both an opportunity and a warning. Pride leads to self-deception and spiritual blindness. True humility helps us to see ourselves as we really are in God's eyes and it inclines us to seek God's help and mercy. God dwells with the humble of heart who recognize their own sinfulness and who acknowledge God's mercy and saving grace. *I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and humble spirit (Isaiah 57:15). God cannot hear us if we boast in ourselves and despise others. Do you humbly seek God's mercy and do you show mercy to others, especially those you find difficult to love and to forgive? Lord Jesus, may your love and truth transform my life - my inner thoughts, intentions, and attitudes, and my outward behavior, speech, and actions. Where I lack charity, kindness, and forbearance, help me to embrace your merciful love and to seek the good of my neighbor, even those who cause me ill-favor or offense. May I always love as you have loved and forgive others as you have forgiven.*

PROTOCOL FOR RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

Every important occasion carries with it clear expectations about how things are to be done. The same is true for what we Catholics consider to be one of the most important occasions of all: receiving our Lord in Holy Communion. There are things to be said and done in certain prescribed ways for the sake of good order and reverence and to express our unity as we receive the Sacrament of Unity.

SIGN OF REVERENCE Each communicant is to make a sign of reverence before receiving the Host and/or Precious Blood. That gesture is to be a bow, to be made just as the person in front of you is receiving.

RECEIVING THE HOST IN THE HAND The proper way to receive the host in the hand is to place one hand flat on top of the other so that the open palm is facing upward. The response to "THE BODY OF CHRIST" IS "AMEN".
