FEAST DAY OF ST. FRANCES X. CABRINI

St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, Virgin (Feast day November 13). Born in Lombardi, Italy in 1850 and died in Chicago, Illinois on December 22, 1917. Filled with a deep trust in God and endowed with a wonderful administrative ability, this remarkable woman soon founded schools, hospitals, and orphanages in the United States and saw them flourish in the aid of Italian immigrants and children. In 1946, she became the first American citizen to be canonized when she was elevated to sainthood by Pope Pius XII. St. Frances is the patroness of immigrants.

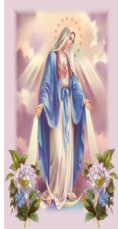

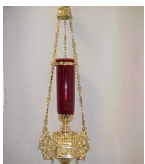
