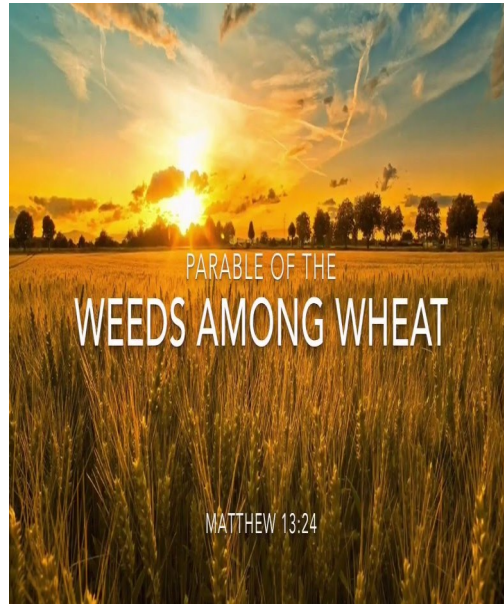

July 17th to July 26th

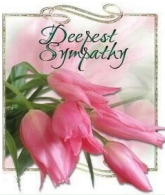

Basilica's main entrance.

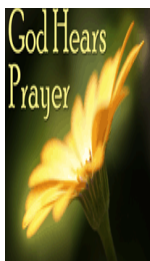
CEMETERY ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT
