The Color Purple

is the traditional color of Lent and represents penance, sorrow, and royalty. During the season of Lent, priests and altar cloths are draped in purple as a sign of mourning for Jesus' death and a reminder of the sacrifices he made. Color purple also symbolizes the royalty of Jesus as the King of Kings. In addition, purple also has a deeper symbolic meaning in Lent. The use of purple during Lent dates back to ancient times when purple was a rare and expensive dye reserved for royalty and the wealthy. The use of this rich, regal color during Lent serves as a reminder of Jesus' true kingship and his triumph over sin & death.

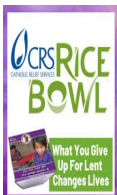

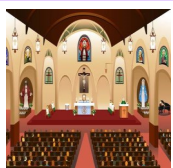
