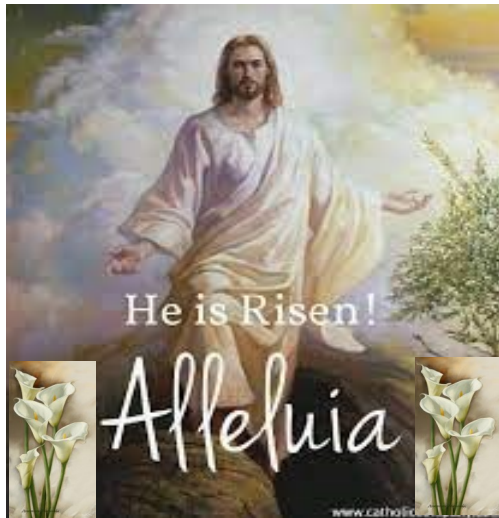

PROTOCOL FOR RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

Every important occasion carries with it clear expectations about how things are to be done. The same is true for what we Catholics consider to be one of the most important occasions of all: receiving our Lord in Holy Communion. There are things to be said and done in certain prescribed ways for the sake of good order and reverence and to express our unity as we receive the Sacrament of Unity.

SIGN OF REVERENCE Each communicant is to make a sign of reverence before receiving the Host.

That gesture is to be a bow, to be made just as the person in front of you is receiving.

RECEIVING THE HOST IN THE HAND The proper way to receive the host in the hand is to place one hand flat on top of the other so that the open palm is facing upward. The response to "THE BODY OF CHRIST" IS "AMEN".

Today we celebrate the Lord's resurrection from the dead, our assurance that God has opened the gates of Heaven and will one day welcome us all into Paradise. Our Lord's resurrection is our resurrection. As you gather with your family and friends to commemorate the feast of Easter may our good and loving God bless you and yours with joy, peace, happiness.
