COMMUNION TO THE HOME BOUND

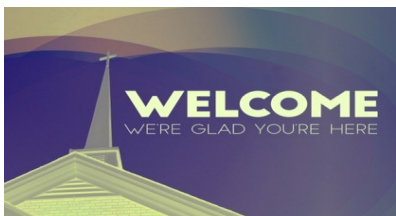
